2017 Lineman Scholarship Rules & Guidelines

Deadline: April 15, 2017

Southeast Electric Cooperative, Inc. will award two \$1,000.00 scholarships to two deserving persons planning to enroll in a Power Line Construction and Maintenance curriculum at an accredited Tech School.

- Applicant must reside within the co-ops service territory.
- Applicant must be a graduating high school senior or have graduated from high school and planning to attend an accredited Tech School to pursue a career in Power Line Construction and Maintenance.
- Applicant must submit a completed scholarship application, personal statement, and a list of school and community activities to the office of Southeast Electric before April 15, 2017.

Scholarships not claimed by December 31, 2017 will be forfeited.
